SUE WILLIAMS The diva of new abstract painting came along a de-cade ago as a polemicist of female grievance, passed through a phase of wristily scribbled orgiastic fan-tasies, and arrived at a style of wide, liquid, speedy brushstrokes in bright colors on hard white grounds. Late de Kooning is an apparent but fully assimi-lated influence, as Williams's screechy pastel swaths make kinetic drama with every bend, loop, and veer. Heraldic to the eye, the works excite the body like a giant's caress. Also in the show are drawings that re-turn, insouciantly, to past themes of teeming erotic wing works. scrimmage.
