

Plus as a reminder, to mark its 50th anniversary, this whole weekend is free at the currently gold-festooned (in a good way) Norton Simon Museum.

Marilyn Minter, Lizzo (Odalisque), 2023–25 (Regen Projects)

Marilyn Minter opens Thursday, November 6, 6-8pm at Regen Projects. Minter lures us back into her mirror-world of surface, glamour, and hyperchromatics, only to crack it wide open once again. Her new enamel-on-panel and enamel-on-wood paintings cross three intertwined series—large-scale compromised celebrity portraits (including images of Jane Fonda and artists Nick Cave, Cindy Sherman, and Jeff Koons), a cohort of arthistorically inclined reclining figures updated for the selfie age (especially Lizzo in lingerie and heels), and a razor-sharp post-Pop suite that riffs on the painterly motifs of Philip Guston. In each case the alluring works shimmer with high-gloss seduction, even as the imagery unsettles and even repulses—on the razor's edge between desire and delusion. *On view in Hollywood through December 20; regenprojects.com.*—SND
