## **SEAN LANDERS: NEW WORK** February 17 - March 16, 1996 Opening reception, Saturday, February 17, 6-8 pm

Regen Projects is pleased to announce an exhibition of new oil paintings, sculpture, video, and pen and ink cartoons by NY artist **Sean Landers**. The centerpiece for the exhibition will be five new paintings based on figures and scenes from William Hogarth's <u>Midnight Modern</u> <u>Conversation</u> (e.g. drunken colonialists hallucinating).

Of the artists to emerge in the 90s **Landers** has most plundered the region of how to make art when the majority of styles and ideas have already been claimed. Oft-mislabeled a "slacker" or "bad boy" artist, the exquisite and thoroughly contemporary intelligence of **Landers'** work emerges in the often self-critical (and thus highly-stylized) trajectory of his oeuvre. From **Landers'** debut of art-world referential drawings on legal pads, or letters to the student loan collection offices (Yale, of course), and sculptures of pot-bellied regular schmoes, to his stream-of-conscious ramblings, or isolated and varied breasts floating across the canvas--**Landers** reveals, despite himself, a classical art training which relies on an honesty, however banal, or Gen-X the reality of today is, to make itself known.

In his most recent group of paintings **Landers** calls forth William Hogarth--in painterly style and characters--for a kind of "men's club" fraternizing. In their drunken stupors these figures mistakes their buddies faces for breasts, see monkeys, or even simply yawn-in-unison of boredom. It's an airless universe, and with his usual ingenious maneuvers, **Landers** incorporates this space to continue his ongoing dialogue with the art world.
